The faculty and staff of North Webster Upper Elementary promote and encourage Parental Involvement to assist in meeting students' needs in all phases of the educational process. Ongoing opportunities for such involvement will arise throughout the school year for interested parties to participate and/or be informed. The Parent Involvement Plan will be reviewed annually and revised as necessary. The following activities will be implemented to increase parental involvement in the school setting:

- Provide parents a digital student/parent quick reference card which is designed and published annually to provide information concerning school policies and procedures, academic guidelines, and current school calendar. A hard copy is available upon request.
- Progress reports will be sent home to inform parents about the academic performance of students.
- Send a daily communication folder home with students so that parents can keep current on their child's work.
- Inform parents about academic achievement standards, the school curriculum and instructional practices; school programs, extracurricular activities, attendance, student's academic performance; and requirements for student placement.

- School will provide each parent an individual student report about the performance of their child on the state assessment by sending home test results as soon as they are made available.
- Inform parents about school-wide activities by using an outdoor sign, school's web page and Facebook page, individual class newsletters, local newspapers, Class Dojo, JCampus automated calls, and Remind.
- Document parent communication about school events with the goal of increasing the parent's overall involvement in the learning process.
- Provide assistance to parents and guardians to develop positive home/school relationships that support children's efforts and provide techniques designed to assist their children with learning at home through the following: Online registration, ESSA Title I virtual Parent meeting, EOY virtual Testing Meeting, instruction of use of Google classroom and other distance learning tools.
