We now have dates and times for our annual Jump Rope for Heart Jump-a-Thon. The Jump-a-Thon has been scheduled for Thursday, March 8th and Friday, March 9th for all 4th, 5th and 6th grade girls in the east gym.

The Jump Rope for Heart Jump-a-Thon is a team event. A team of four jumpers will take turns jumping a rope for a 20 minute time period. Each team member's jumps will be counted. When a jumper tires, reaches the maximum number of jumps, or stops; another team member will begin to jump. Jumpers will rotate in order until time is up. At the end of the time, jumps will be totaled to determine the team's jumping total. I need volunteers to help count jumps that can stay for either a morning or afternoon session. It would also be beneficial to know as soon as possible who can help. It would be greatly appreciated!
