

An update from the Kansas Department of Health and Environment has been made in regards to students attending school after a positive diagnosis of Influenza.

K.A.R. 28-1-6 now states that each person with a case of influenza is required to be isolated at home for seven days following the onset of illness except when seeking medical care.

- For isolation purposes, a case of influenza is a person who has tested positive for influenza, whether that be by a rapid, PCR, or other influenza test and is experiencing symptoms of influenza-like illness.
- Cases of influenza who received this year's vaccine are not exempt from isolation requirements.
