Lincoln Alternative Methods of Instruction Family Facts Newsletter

Lincoln Alternative Methods of Instruction (AMI) Days defined: Act 862 allows a public school district to develop a plan for alternative methods of instruction to be used on days when the superintendent closes school due to exceptional or emergency circumstances.

The **Superintendent** will announce the Lincoln AMI days at the same time as the school cancellation.

LCSD Faculty:

- Monitor student activity by electronic means if internet connection is available during the hours between 8:00-3:30.
- Teachers will not be available to students during their normal lunch period nor during their regular planning period.
- Student questions will be answered through electronic means (Example: email, phone, summit learning, or Google hangouts) based on the teacher's individual classroom procedures.

Lincoln AMI Assignments:

- Are grade level appropriate assignments created for the student(s) by the teachers.
- Must have a logical connection to the regular classroom content standards.
- Are designed to deepen understanding and help build essential skills.

Lincoln AMI Packets:

- Lincoln Elementary (Pre-k -3rd) hard copy and digital copy for parents to print in AMI Folder.
- Lincoln Middle School (4th-7th) hard copy and digital copy utilizing students' home computers.
- Lincoln High School (8th-12th) hard and digital copy utilizing the students' one to one school provided computers.

AMI Attendance will be based on assignment completion. A student will be counted as "present" when assigned AMI work is completed and returned to school within 5 days of the designated AMI School Day. A student's failure to return the assigned AMI work will count as a "absence" for the designated AMI School Day.
