Thursday, September 3 – Face to Face Students

Tuesday, September 8 – Virtual Students

Introduction

For students attending school face to face, the orientation is scheduled for Thursday, September 3rd. While there will be no general assembly, an instructional video created by the NISH administration will become available on the school's official website on that day. All students and their parents are to view the video prior to returning to school as it will not only contain our policies and procedures, but also discuss important safety protocols. Although there will be no general assembly, students will receive many important resources and information at the event. All students will be assessed a flat orientation fee of \$25.

If a student will be beginning the year virtually, their orientation will be held on Tuesday, September 8.

Materials Received

At the orientation, students will receive their schedule, an ID, lanyard, locker information, and an orientation packet. In this packet, parents will find a Chromebook and internet usage forms. Students attending school on the physical campus must have these forms completed when they return to campus on September 10 and 11 in order to receive a Chromebook. For students utilizing the virtual model, a Chromebook will be distributed at the orientation once Chromebook and Internet usage forms are signed and submitted. The forms will be available on the school's website prior to orientation. It is highly encouraged that parents print and sign prior to orientation if utilizing the virtual model.

Social Distancing Guidelines

In order to comply with the CDC guidelines, the following requirements are in place:

- The student (in uniform for face-to-face students) and a parent/guardian are allowed into the building only.
- All must wear a mask.
- All participants will have their temperature checked. Entry will be denied to anyone with a temperature at or above 100.4.
- Maintain a six distance between members of separate households while waiting in line.

Arrival Times

The student and their parent must arrive at their designated time. Groups are limited to less than 50 per grade level. The last name of the student determines the time. Use the table below to determine the appropriate timeslot:

Example: If the student's last name were Boudreaux, that student would attend at 8:00 AM. If the student's name were Thibodeaux then that student would attend orientation at 12:30 PM.

Example: If the student's last name were Rodrigue, that student would attend at 10:15 AM.

While on Campus

Once participants arrive on campus, the student and their parent must enter a designated hallway based on their grade level. It is highly recommended that parents utilize the district's Student Progress Center (<https://pcc.iberia.k12.la.us/progress/>) for their child's accurate grade level. If still unsure, NISH staff will be available at the entryways to assist in verifying the student's grade level
