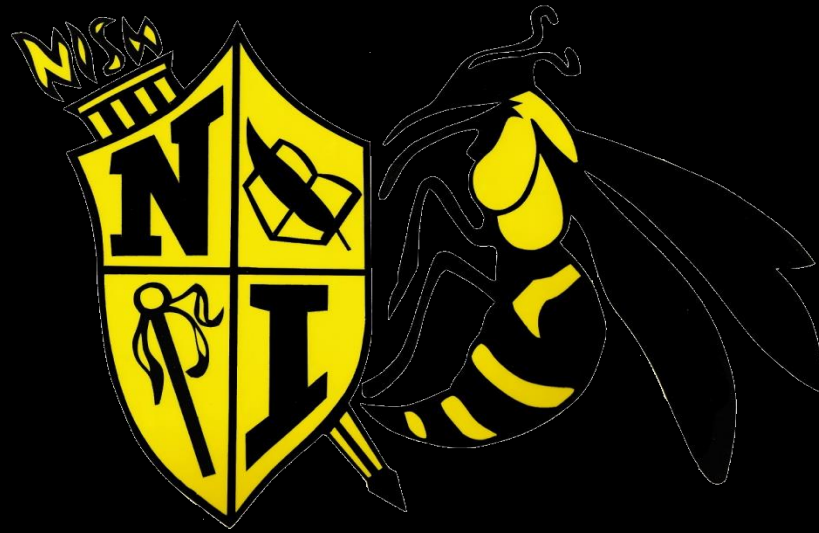

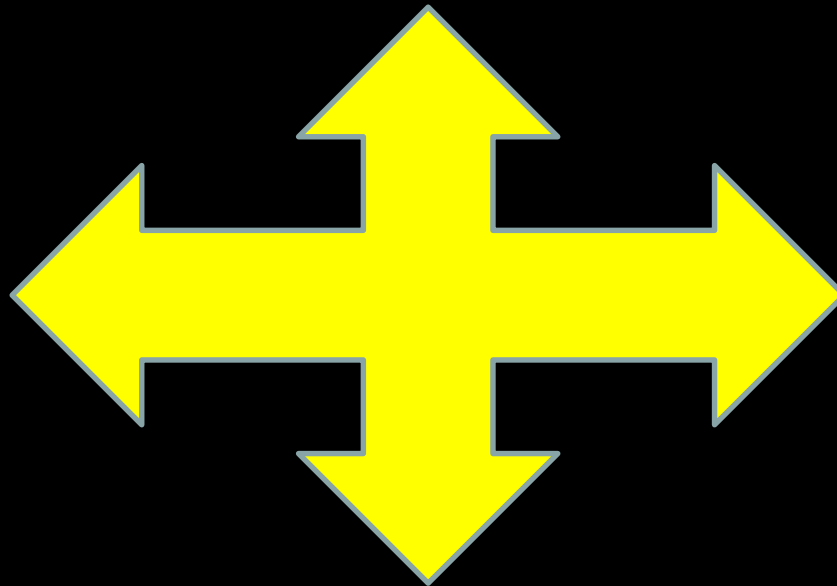

## *Test Recovery and Grading Period Recovery*

1. **Assessment/Test Recovery –**  
Sign up with your teacher
2. See Mrs. Angelle Ransonet in the library to sign up. You will fill out a form with her, then she calls you in to give you the information to begin the Grading Period Recovery. You must sign up with a week of receiving your report card and you have until the end of the following grading period to complete the recovery—including taking the cumulative exam.
