

KHS Prom Guidelines 2019

Prom Details: March 30, 2019 KHS Gymnasium Arrive: 6:30-7:30 pm
Photos: 6:30-9:00 pm Senior walk: 8:00 pm Dance: 8:00-11:00 PM

Tickets: Senior and one guest admitted free of charge. Limit of two tickets per student.
Single ticket: \$15 Couple's ticket \$25 Cash preferred, checks payable to KHS

Date/Guest Information:

Each junior/senior may bring one guest (KHS student or non KHS student)

All guests that are non KHS students **MUST** be **pre approved**. Guest form must be turned in minimum of 7 days prior to event. All guests must be at least a freshman in high school and no older than 21. (proof of age may be requested). KHS reserves the right to refuse admittance to any non pre-approved guest or those lacking proof of age

Behavior:

Prom is a school event, appropriate school behavior is expected. All attendees must enter at the front of the school building. Breathalyzer begins at 6:30. Local law enforcement and KHS have the right to deny entrance or remove any attendee exhibiting inappropriate behavior. Prom is a lock in--**Doors will be locked at 8:00, no exit or return**

Dress code:

High School Prom is a formal event and only formal attire will be allowed. While the Vermilion Parish School Board will be reasonable in its interpretation, students should know they will not be allowed entrance if they are not dressed properly. If students are uncertain whether or not the attire is acceptable, they should turn in a picture of themselves in the dress or other attire to an administrator at least seven days prior to the event for approval.

Formal Gowns:

- Dresses may be strapless, however, they may not be cut below the bust-line in the front. (This includes cut outs below the bust line.) No excessive cleavage will be permitted.
- Appropriate undergarments must be worn with your dress or top (built-in or separate).
- Dresses must cover the mid-section fully. Netting, mesh, illusion, chiffon or any other see-through material in the bodice of the dress is not acceptable. Opaque fabric must cover any see-through material.
- Two-piece dresses/outfits must not expose any flesh at the mid-section of the body (front and side).
- Dresses may not have a slit that exceeds mid-thigh. This includes side, front, and back slits. Dresses may be backless as long as they are not cut below the height of the navel.
- The hemline must not exceed seven inches above the floor when in a kneeling position.
- Shawls, boleros, cardigans or wraps are acceptable but not to cover unacceptable dress
- In the event of an inappropriate dress, administration can require the student to wear a cover-up before entering the event.
- Dress shoes are recommended. Sandals, cowboy boots, dress boots and athletic shoes are allowed. Flip flops are not permitted.

Tuxedo/Suit:

- Formal evening attire such as a tuxedo or suit with tie/bow tie is expected. Shirts must be long-sleeved, dress shirt with a collar.
- Top hats, canes, and gloves are allowed.
- Appropriate dress shoes must be worn. Cowboy boots, dress boots and athletic shoes are allowed. Flip flops are not permitted.

Plan ahead: wear clothing that is complementary and will not restrict you from enjoying prom. It is the responsibility of the KHS student to share these guidelines with a non-KHS student guest. Appropriate formal attire is required by all attendees for the entire event. If there is any question about your attire, please contact Mrs. Katelyn (katelyn.bares@vpsb.net) by March 22.
