

**MEDICINE LAKE SCHOOL
SUPPLY LIST
2019-20 SCHOOL YEAR**

KINDERGARTEN:

- 1 pair gym shoes
- 1 backpack/book bag
- 1 plastic pencil box that snaps shut
- 1 box of 8 regular crayons (red, orange, yellow green, blue, purple, black, brown)
(it is usually cheaper to buy the 24 ct crayons & pick out these 8 colors)
- 1 box of 8 large or triangular washable crayons
- 1 box conical (wide barrel) tip washable markers
- 1 eraser
- 6 glue sticks (.21 oz.)
- 1 box of crackers per month (no cookies)

PLEASE WRITE YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON THE ITEMS ABOVE (PERMANENT MARKER)

Very much appreciated donations:

- glue sticks
- mittens, gloves

FIRST GRADE:

- 1 pair of clean gym shoes (used or new)
- 1 book bag/backpack
- 1 plastic pencil box that snaps shut
- 1 box crayons (no less than 8, no more than 24))
- 1 box conical (wide barrel) tip washable markers
- 4 glue sticks (recommend Elmer's Disappearing Purple)
- 2 boxes of snacks (please label) When your child finishes the first box, the empty box will be sent home so you have time to send another before the second box is empty)

PLEASE LABEL THE ABOVE ITEMS WITH PERMANENT MARKERS

Suggested supplies to be kept at home for homework and practice:

A container for pencils, pencil sharpener, glue stick, blunt end scissors, erasers and crayons to be kept at home for homework.

A "night before school basket or bag" so that homework, Wednesday envelopes, library books, and winter gear will be ready to go when it is time to leave for school each morning.

Very Much Appreciated Donations:

- boxes of crayons
- 12 or more pencils for the class to share
- play dough (store or homemade)
- glue sticks
- mittens, gloves, sweat or wind pants
- Ziploc bags (any size brand)
- paper or plastic cups (any size or brand)
- napkins (any size, brand)
- paper lunch bags (new, any size or brand)

OPTIONAL ITEMS: spill-proof water bottle with lid (TAKE HOME DAILY TO BE WASHED.

DOES NOT NEED TO CONTAIN WATER-CAN BE FILLED AT SCHOOL.

SHOULD NOT CONTAIN JUICE, POP, OR ANYTHING OTHER THAN WATER

Clear, clean plastic jar with lid - one quart or larger to be used to grow plants.

Large Peanut butter jars work great

PLEASE DO NOT send extra items such as pencils, pens, erasers, rulers, note books, tablets, or novelty items. Extra items will be returned the first day of school. Thank you!

- 3 spiral notebooks (wide ruled around 80 pages)
- colored pencils
- 1 ruler
- water bottle with lid(can be filled at school)
- markers (optional)

*glue sticks & 1 bottle of **white** glue (4 oz.)

*snack items (crackers, gold fish, pretzels, etc. – animal or graham crackers are fine, no cookies please – 1 box per month to **share** with class)

***indicates shared materials (teacher will store and distribute as needed)**
