

## **BLANCHARD PUBLIC SCHOOLS CHILD FIND PROGRAM**

Child Find is a public awareness activity to identify, locate, and evaluate children ages 3 through, 21 years of age if necessary, who may have disabilities that are defined under the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA) of 2004. A child with a disability means, a child evaluated and determined eligible for special education and related services in accordance with the Policies and Procedures of Special Education in Oklahoma.

Blanchard Public School District is responsible for locating, evaluating, and identifying children with disabilities who live within our District's boundaries. All eligible children with disabilities, beginning at age 3, who are residents of the Blanchard Public School District, have the right to a Free and Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) as mandated by IDEA. The specific special education and related services for each individual child is determined by the child's Individualized Education Program (IEP) team.
