

2020-2021 Calhoun Minks Basketball



Due to the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, Calhoun Elementary School, along with McMinn County Schools, will be following CDC guidelines during the 2020-21 elementary basketball season. The following procedures will be in place at Calhoun School:

- A limited number of passes will be given out for both home and away games. Basketball players and cheerleaders' families will get priority to the passes. If passes remain, they will be available to the general public.
- Passes are not free. Each pass is \$2.00 and must be paid to the gate keeper upon arrival to the game. The pass must be turned in to the gate keeper along with the money.
- Passes are labeled either "Boys game" or "Girls game". You must have a pass to enter each game if planning to attend both games. Each game will cost \$2.00. So, if you have a pass to both games, your cost for the night will be \$4.00, paid upon entry to each individual game.
- The gym must be completely cleared after the girls' game is finished. At that time, individuals with passes for the boys' game will be allowed into the gym. If arriving for the boys' game only, you will not be allowed to enter the gym while the girls' game is still being played. You will have to wait until the gym is completely cleared.
- Calhoun will have 114 passes for girls and boys home games. Coach Tucker, Coach Cantrell, and Coach Burnsed will distribute passes to their athletes. Any remaining passes will be available for purchase at the gate. When the last pass is purchased, the game will officially be sold out.
- Calhoun has distributed 54 visitor passes to each school for their fans. Each visiting team has done the same with Calhoun. The number for each away game is different due to the size of the schools' gyms. Coach Tucker, Coach Cantrell, and Coach Burnsed will distribute away game passes to their athletes. If any extra passes are available for away games, they will be distributed by that school in accordance to their policy.
- Children who are not already in school will be permitted to enter free of charge with their parent/guardian possessing a pass. All children and families will be expected to sit together in the bleachers for the entire contest unless visiting the concession stand or using the restroom.
- Concessions will be sold on the stage. A limited number of items will be available.
- All fans must wear a mask upon entering and temperatures will be taken at the gate. Anyone running a fever of 100.4 or higher will not be allowed to enter. We ask that you please screen yourselves for Covid-19 symptoms before traveling to the gym. We highly encourage that you keep your mask on at all times while in the gym.
- All fans will exit the gym at the side door between the two sets of bleachers immediately after the game is over. Gathering on the court to talk after the game will not be allowed.
