This suspension of normal school operations, taken in conjunction with surrounding districts, is in support of the overall effort to “flatten the curve” of the COVID-19 pandemic.

We will provide information to parents by noon on Friday (April 3rd) for the next weeks (April 6th – May 1st) extended learning.

All district events and extracurricular activities are canceled until the District reopens or further notice.

Once again Westphalia ISD will extend the closure through **May 1, 2020** and we will provide updates on an ongoing basis.
