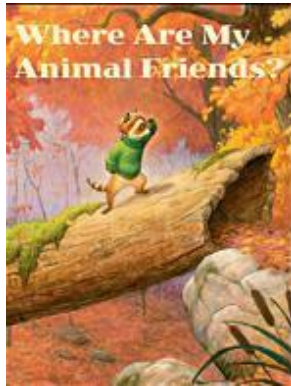


UNIT 3: Story 6

Story: Where Are My Animal Friends?



Phonics Skills:

*comparative endings -er, -est

Examples: smart, smarter, smartest thin, thinner, thinnest

*dge /j/

Examples: bridge, badge, dodge, pledge

Comprehension Skill: Sequence

Events in a story happen in a certain order. Words such as first, then, next, and last can help readers figure out the order of events.

High-Frequency Words:

does good-bye before won't oh right

Grammar Skill: Contractions with Not

A **contraction** is a short way to put two words together. A **verb** and the word **not** can be put together to make a contraction. An **apostrophe** (') is used in the place of the letter o.

Examples: are + not = aren't has + not = hasn't do + not = don't
