

Severe Allergies

The district requires that upon enrollment of a student who is considered to have a severe allergy disclose this information to the district so that necessary precautions can be taken to protect the student's safety. It is important to disclose the allergen to which the student is allergic, as well as the nature of the allergic reaction. Please contact the school nurse or campus principal if your child has a known allergy or as soon as possible after any diagnosis of a severe allergy. The district has developed a severe allergy action plan which must be on file at the appropriate campus. When the district receives information that a student has a severe allergy that puts the student at risk for anaphylaxis, individual care plans will be developed to assist the student in safely accessing the school environment.
