- SERVICES START DATE: July 1, 2016

If the Service Provider cannot complete the fiber project by July 1, 2016, the Service Provider must provide alternative internet and campus connectivity at the cost of the Service Provider at a minimum of 50 Mbps to each DMARC and provide a completion date for the entire project.

- PAYMENT TERMS: School district may consider a multi-year contract for services.
 USAC funding commitments may experience a temporary funding delay depending on PIA
 review process. Service provider must agree to begin transport services upon school order
 request and no later than by July 1, 2016, including any special construction or considerations
 (if any). The School acknowledges if USAC denies funding, the school will be liable for costs
 for the funding year.
- ERATE TERMS: All terms and conditions as required by Universal Service Administration Company Schools and Library (E-Rate Program) must be met. Service Provider must have USAC portal access and SPIN# (Service Provider Identification Number) and provide on bid response.

 Must include all configuration, installation, special construction information and costs by each site location.
