USAWOA Mid America Chapter 2016 Scholarship Checklist and Application

INSTRUCTIONS:

The application packet must be complete and all documents submitted together. *ALL transcripts (electronic copy), letters of recommendations and other required documents MUST be sent to USAWOA0303Scholarship@gmail.com no later than April 15, 2016.* All documents must be submitted in .pdf format, with files named in the following format: "LAST NAME TITLE OF DOCUMENT." For example, "RUSINE DISCUSSION ESSAY" "RUSINE TRANSCRIPT" etc.

Photographs of applicants will result in disqualification and should not be included.

Scholarships are judged and awarded without regard to gender, race, color, religion, national origin or disability. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

ELIGIBILITY:

High school seniors who go to school or reside within 50 miles of the Fort Riley, KS military installation, who have the commitment to continue their education.

CHECKLIST (6 items total):

- Scholarship Application (see form following this checklist)
- Discussion essay on the military with the following criteria:
 - Topic: How has the military impacted your life?
 - Use standard letter paper, double spaced, font size 12, Times New Roman.
 - Title centered on the first page. No cover page.
 - Utilize a header, with the name of the applicant on the top left, and page numbers on the top right.
 - Word count is a minimum of 800 words, maximum of 1000 words.
 - The essay must be correctly cited, with a reference page in accordance with MLA standards.
- Copy of high school transcript. Home schooled students include transcripts for grade 9 through current year must be sent with application. All scholarship applicants must have a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 based on a 4.0 scale or the equivalent GPA on the scale used by the applicable educational institution.
- Copy of ACT or SAT scores.

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- Letters of recommendation (at least one but not to exceed three from high school now attending). Letter should cover applicant's ability, work habits, integrity, character, potential, and volunteer activities.
- Detailed list of extra-curricular activities, honors received, and scholastic achievements. Address school and community activities separately. Address the length and efforts of involvement as well as offices held. Also list any training received outside of school.

Only winners are notified of the Scholarship Committee's decision. We will have one winner in 2016. The scholarship will be awarded as \$1,000 to first place. If fundraising garners funds in excess of \$1,000, the remaining funds will be distributed to second and third place awardees. The awards will be presented in the month of June 2016. Scholarship must be used within one year of date of award, or it is forfeited.
