Scholarship Requirements:

3. The following should be included in the application;
 - a. The completed application form.
 - b. A short essay explaining your educational goals and financial needs.
 - c. Two letters of recommendation from non-relatives such as a teacher, community member, or employer.
 - d. Copy of your high school transcript.
 - e. Resume detailing activities and achievements.

This scholarship is in the amount of \$500; to be allotted \$250 at the beginning of the first semester, and \$250 at the beginning of the second semester.
