The Abilene Class of 1964 Memorial Scholarship was established in 2016. Classmates of the graduating class of 1964 created this scholarship after their 50th class reunion. Their LEGACY lives through the memory of their high school days, the educational foundation they received attending Abilene High School and assisting future Abilene High School Graduates.

Scholarship Overview:

This scholarship is intended to assist with post-high school education expenses for a graduating high school senior of Abilene High School.

Scholarship Requirements:

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior from Abilene High School with a class ranking of 50% or above.
2. Applicant must plan to attend a four-year college, community college or a technical college.
3. Applicant must have earned at least a cumulative 3.0 GPA.
4. Applicant must have been actively involved in one or more school activities.
5. The following shall be included in the application:
 - a. Typed statement/essay of 200 words describing why applicant deserves the scholarship.
 - b. Copy of Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the resulting Student Aid Report (SAR), including "expected family contribution".
 - c. Two letters of recommendation (original signed) from non-relative such as teacher, community member or employer.
 - d. Current resume detailing activities and community service work.
 - e. Copy of most current academic transcript.

Complete application cover page and attach all required information in the order listed.
