

# Public Health Preparedness (PHP) Report

The Public Health Preparedness (PHP) Report is a monthly publication designed to provide emergency preparedness news and education as it relates to public health. This will include monthly communicable disease reports which provide a summary of the number of cases of reportable diseases by month.

The PHP Report is issued by Public Health Preparedness which is a division of the City of Lubbock 's Emergency Management and consists of four full-time staff. PHP is funded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and is administered by the Texas Department of State Health Services.

The overall mission of PHP is to increase response capabilities to public health threats including chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear, and explosive events (CBRNE), and natural disasters.
