

WJRC Update

Basketball season is wrapping up. For the 5^{1st} and 2nd grade teams we made them co-ed for the first time and we think that it worked out pretty well as the teams were able to play a round robin schedule instead of the same couple of boys or girls teams. We also had 3 teams between boys and girls in each of the 3rd/4th and 5th/6th division. Wellsville had a very successful basketball season this year with all teams competing at a high level.

Starting the first of February the Recreation Board began the process of signing up the kids for baseball, tball, softball and spring soccer. We have had a very positive response to those signups so far and look forward to strong numbers in those sports. It is always a busy time so be on the lookout for soccer games to start at the end of March and summer ball to start in May.

WJRC is in the process of identifying some capital improvements for the 15-16 budget year. Current projects for this year that we need to do are to fix the batting cages and to see if we can add some bullpens to the main baseball field. We currently have the supplies from old projects to complete them. It will just be finding some time and labor to do it.

We have discussed having a community wide trash pick up day at the all field site. We continue to monitor the weather to see if we can find a Saturday where kids and families can be comfortable.

Finally, the WJRC board is still in the process of looking for a head grounds keeper and a new recreation director. The interest is strong but the board wants to make sure that we find the best candidate for the job.
