Local School Wellness Plan Revision

The SHAC reviewed progress made on the Local School Wellness Plan. The committee agreed to accept the LWP as written even though final regulations by the USDA are pending. Cindy Clendennen shared with the committee activities that have been completed that are reflected in the Plan.

The Annual Performance process will begin in the next two weeks with information gathered from each campus. Once reviewed and compiled, the district report will be completed and submitted to the SHAC at the April 2nd meeting. Upon acceptance, the APR will be publicized at a school board meeting at the end of the school year.

Traci Younts, ACE Director served as guest speaker. She shared information about ACE and activities students participate in. She also shared information about the HEB Community Challenge which launched January 1, 2015 and is in its third year. It is a competition which spans over four months. The goal of the competition is to challenge communities across the state to compete to see which can demonstrate the greatest commitment to healthy living. The intent is to unite and mobilize schools, businesses, organizations, community members, and leaders toward the common goal of transforming their community's health. Mrs. Younts will explore the possibility of launching this program within Beeville supported by ACE and BISD schools.
