

Art Room Rules and Expectations

I have high expectations for all my students in art. In order for us to have a safe learning environment students are expected to follow art room rules as well as all school rules as listed in the Student Handbook.

- You are expected to make good CHOICES at all times.

1. RESPECT is the number one rule in the art room.

Be respectful of...

- **our room.** Keep it clean. Place your assignments and all supplies in your bin when you leave the room. Be very careful to place your bin in the correct cubby in the closet. Graded work should be taken home or stored *neatly* in your portfolio. If it gets full, take graded work home.

- **our supplies.** Use tools only as they are intended. Be responsible for classroom materials, books, art supplies, etc. that you use during class. Return them to their proper location. Wash paintbrushes, palettes, and water containers and return them to their proper location. **DO NOT** leave paint supplies or paper towels in the sink. Purposefully damaged materials will be replaced by those responsible and parents will be contacted.

- **ourselves.** We will always do our best in all ways. Practice personal & academic integrity.

- **each other.** Respect others' personal space. Always be aware of the tools you are using and the people working around you, avoiding all behaviors that could be harmful. Respect the dignity of everyone, learning from others' ideas, respecting their opinions, and having concern for others and the conditions which support the development of their artwork.

- **all school personnel.** Be silent when teachers are teaching and maintain appropriate behavior for each situation. You may talk quietly while working, but this privilege will be lost if it becomes too loud, disruptive or a distraction from work.)

2. When the bell rings, be in your assigned seat, attentive and ready for instruction.
Being tardy more than three times will result in detention.

3. Stay on task, and do not wander around the room or visit at other tables.
Stay seated in your assigned seat unless you are getting supplies or cleaning up.

4. Do not take supplies from anywhere without permission.

5. Do not touch the paper cutter.

Take pride in yourself, your work, and your school. Your best effort is expected.
