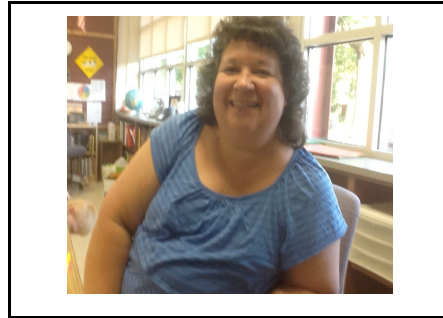


Mrs. Heiman
