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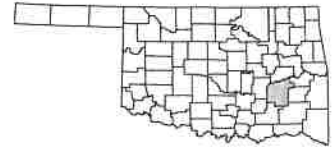

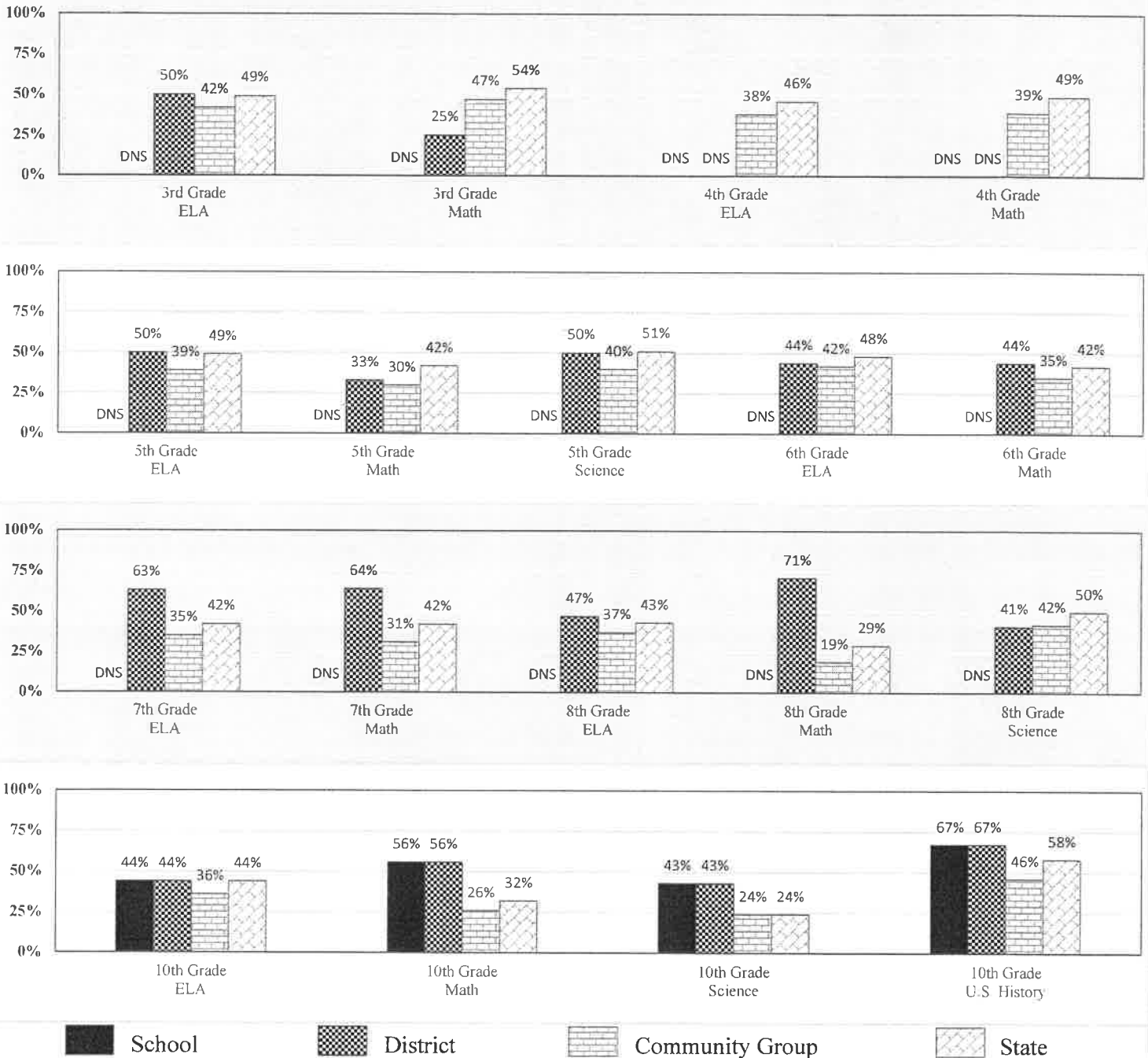
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**2016-17 Student Performance** (Regular Education Students, Full Academic Year at This Site)

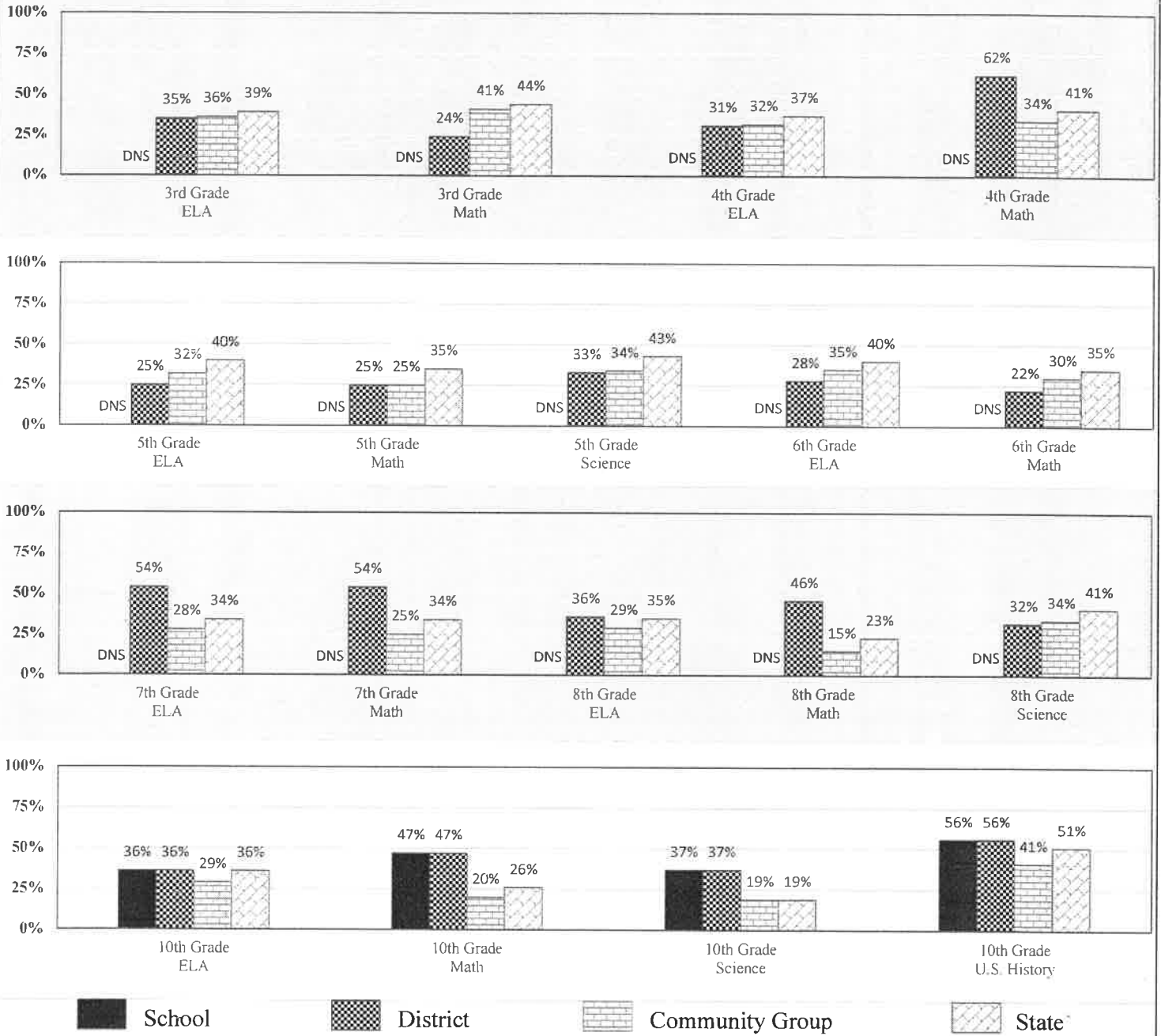

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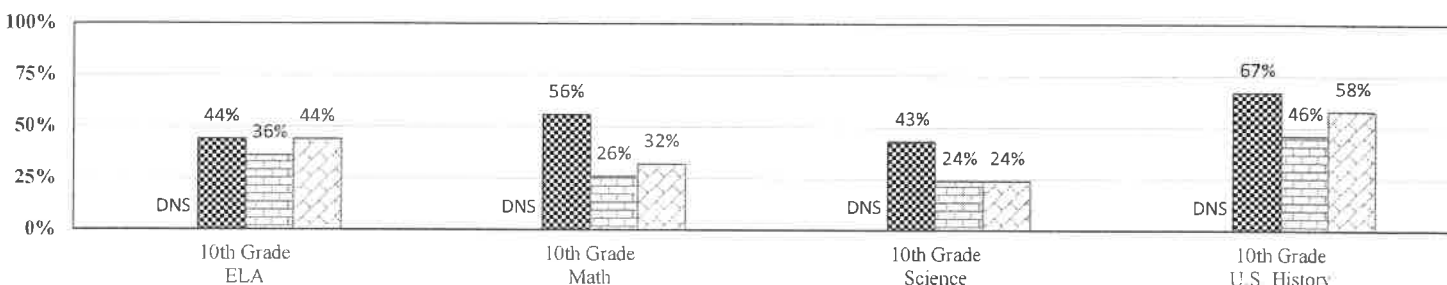
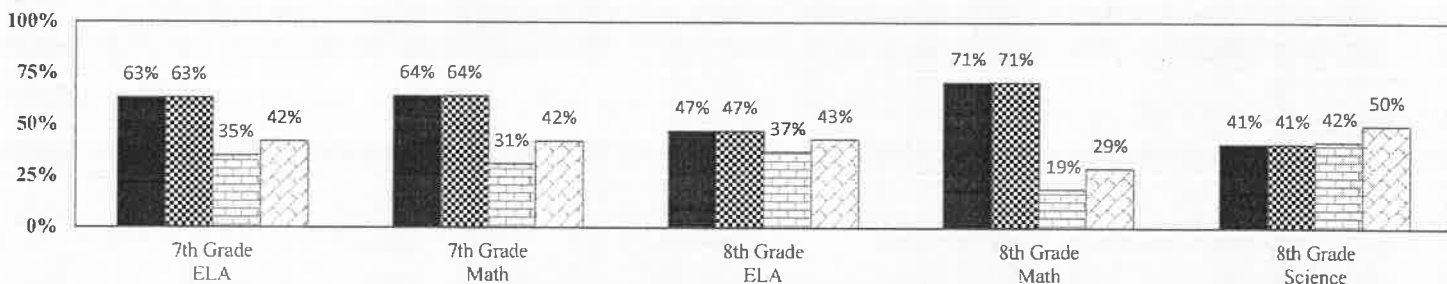
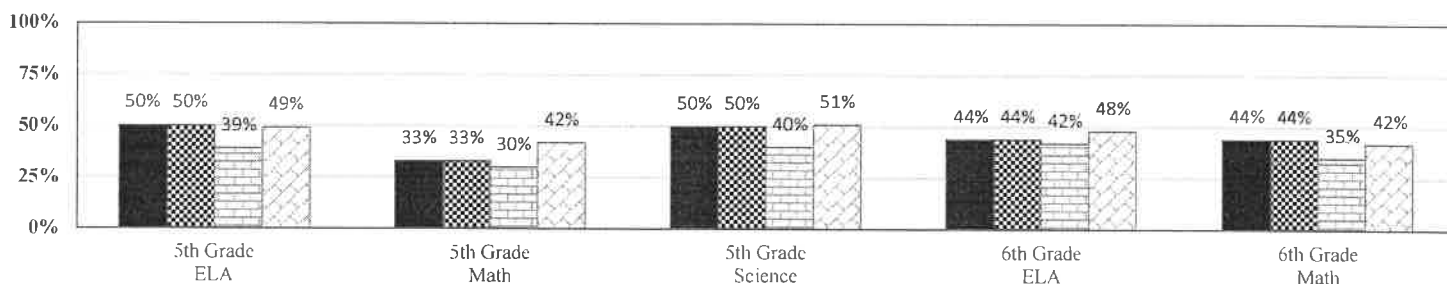
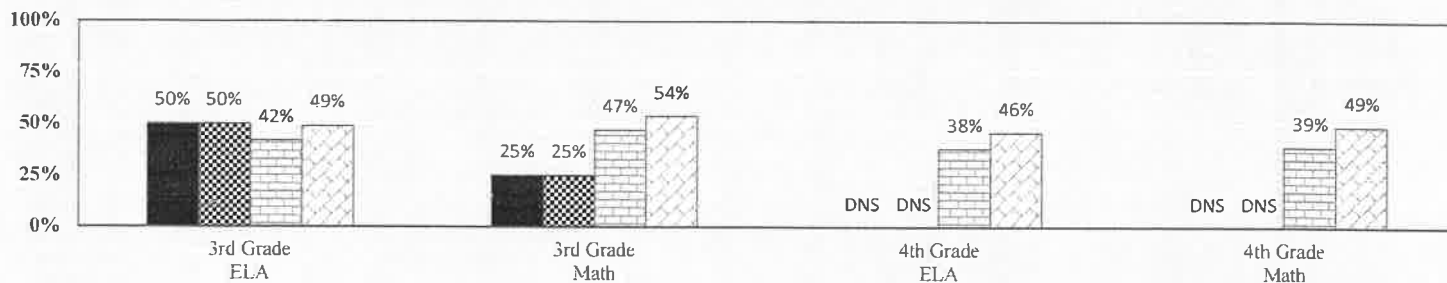
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# 2016-17 Student Performance *(Regular Education Students, Full Academic Year at This Site)*

## % of Students Scoring Proficient and Above by Grade and Subject



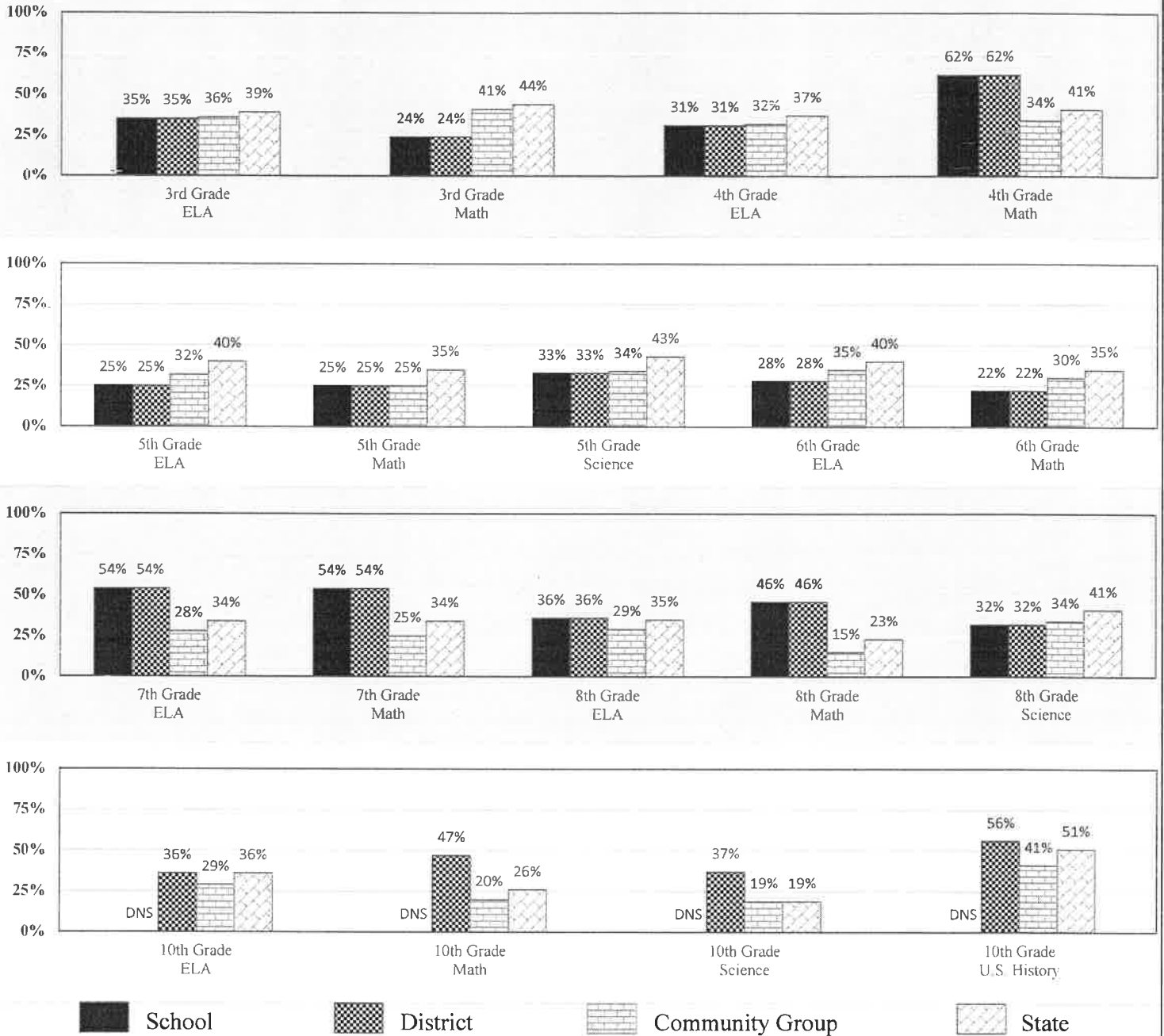
