## Severe Weather Procedure



In the event of severe weather, the following procedures will be followed:

The School District will be in communication with the Grady County Emergency Management Office, Rush Springs Fire Department, and Rush Springs Police Department.

If weather conditions warrant the students and faculty/staff of Rush Springs Public Schools to proceed to the District's storm shelter, a message will be posted on the school website and school Facebook page, and an "all call" will go out stating that severe weather precautions are being taken.

Once the decision has been made to take shelter, all students and faculty/staff will remain in place until the all-clear signal has been given.

**During the shelter-in-place period, no students will be allowed to leave the storm shelter. Parents and/or guardians will not be allowed to pick up any student during this time. The shelter is the safest place for the students and faculty/staff.**

After the all-clear, students and faculty/staff will return to their respective buildings and parents/guardians will be allowed to check out their student(s) if they so choose.
