

SUMMER DRIVERS EDUCATION 2019

The Andover District is pleased to announce plans for the 2019 Drivers Education Program. Students will have the option of enrolling in either an on-line or a traditional option:

ON-LINE

Students that enroll in the on-line course will receive course books and will have access to the coursework via a web address and a password that will be provided. To pass the course, students must have 80% mastery on module tests and the final. Students are encouraged to do the chapter reviews at the end of the chapters to help prepare for each module quiz and module test, and to use the study guide for the final. All module tests must be completed before taking the final. Students will have access to the material from May 1 through May 29. The final is required and will be administered at Andover Central High School at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 30, 2019.

TRADITIONAL

Students will still have the option of taking the course in the traditional classroom model. The class size will depend on the number of students that take this option, but it is usually very large. Students must attend all classroom sessions. The dates and times of the sessions are:

ACHS and AHS students must bring their charged chromebooks to class each day. ACMS, AMS & Out of District students will be provided a chromebook.

The driving portion of the course is the same for both options. Students will sign up for a 7-day session (weekdays only.) We will fill each session by age (**oldest to youngest**) for the applications received by March 18. **Any received after that date will be assigned according to when received rather than age.**

Students receive high school credit for this course and the grade will count towards their cumulative G.P.A. A copy of the course curriculum is available upon request.

Re: Personal Injury Protection (PIP) Coverage

While we take every reasonable precaution to avoid accidents, it is possible that your son or daughter might be involved in a motor vehicle accident while in a driver's education vehicle.

The State of Kansas is a "no fault" insurance state, which means one looks to his or her own automobile insurance company for coverage for medical expenses before asking a negligent driver to respond to a claim resulting from an auto accident.

You should be aware that Unified School District #385 is not required to purchase "no fault" personal injury protection (PIP) coverage on driver's education vehicles. Therefore, if your son or daughter is injured while occupying the driver's education vehicle, the insurance policy covering your family auto will be primary.

If there is no family automobile insurance applicable, then a secondary source of coverage will be the insurance covering the automobile driven by the person responsible for the accident.
