STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT AND HANDBOOK:

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Credit Recovery

Credit Recovery courses are for students who have previously taken a course on campus, but failed to earn credit. Students may enroll in these courses **ONLY** with counselor approval. These courses use an online self-paced curriculum that does not allow for modification of content or instructional delivery. These factors should be carefully considered before enrollment if a student requires content modifications and/or instructional accommodations.

Each ½ credit course will be offered both sessions, contingent upon enrollment requests. Students may only register for two courses (1/2 credit) per summer school session. Students may earn a maximum of one (1) Unless approved by the counselor.
