**Dyslexia Program**

During the 2017-2018 school year, Centerpoint School District used the evidenced-based *Orton Gillingham: Recipe for Reading* dyslexia intervention program in small group intervention to address the deficit areas of students identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.

**Dyslexia Interventionists**

Each dyslexia interventionist received training for the requirements of this subchapter through *Orton Gillingham Multi-sensory Training* from the Institute for Multi-Sensory Education.

**Number of Students Who Received Dyslexia Intervention**

During the 2017-2018 school year, 34 students attending Centerpoint Public School District received dyslexia intervention services from a trained dyslexia interventionist.

**Total Number of Students Identified with Dyslexia**

During the 2017-2018 school year, 9 students attending Centerpoint Public School District were identified with dyslexia characteristics.
