Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the following procedures will be in place during the 2020-2021 basketball season. These procedures will apply to Bismarck School District Home games only:

- Seating capacity will be 100 spectators per home and visitor sides of the gym. The home side will be the South side (away from the benches) and the visitor side will be the North side (behind the benches). Please refer to the signs posted in the gym.
- 2 Vouchers will be provided to each player and cheerleader for the games in which they participate. Vouchers must be presented in order to purchase a ticket.
- Ticket vouchers for the public will be available through the high school office on the day of the game.
- You must provide a voucher for each game you plan to attend. Vouchers for all games must be provided upon entry. We will stamp your hand to ensure you only pay one time to enter.
- We will clear the gymnasium following each game. There are no exceptions to this rule. If you enter, you must exit and re-enter for the next game. We must do this in order to ensure we do not exceed capacity.
- All persons will exit on the south side of the gymnasium.
- Seating is marked in the bleachers with an "X". We have seating arranged in compliance with the AAA and Governor's guidelines. Please adhere to the seating arrangements in the gym.
- Masks must be worn at all times. Those not in compliance will be asked to leave.

While these procedures are anything but conventional, we must strictly adhere to guidelines provided to us by AAA and the Governor.
