(nominations due by end of the month; first month is September; last is April)

Qualifications:

- *Innovation (i.e. trying new things; reaching out beyond the status quo, etc.)
- *Positive relationship-building with students, staff, and parents
- *Leadership (i.e. coaching, committee member, team leader, etc.)
- *Punctuality and Professionalism (i.e. communicates well, attendance, etc.)

Applications must be completed by the last day of each month at 4pm and submitted via the Google Form on our website or by paper copies available in each school office and District Office. The Renwick District Leadership Team will determine the winners. There will be four winners each month, one certified K-8 teacher, one certified high school teacher, one classified K-8 staff member, and one high school classified staff member. Each monthly nominee will be notified of their nomination. Monthly winners will receive a Certificate of Excellence, be recognized at the monthly Board of Education meeting, and receive a \$100 award. Monthly winners will be entered in the Renwick Teacher of the Year award process. The Renwick Elementary Teacher of the Year and the Renwick Secondary Teacher of the Year will become the district's nominees for Kansas Teacher of the Year and will receive a \$1,000 award.
