- One Durable 3" three ring binder notebook (NO zip binders)
- One 1" three ring binder with plastic on the outside cover
- Two Packages WIDE ruled notebook paper
- One Three- ring binder plastic zipper bag to hold small supplies
- Five Composition Books [English 2, Math, Reading, Science] + 1 for STAAR Reading
- One One subject spiral notebook [PROS class]
- One Package of twelve map pencils [Social Studies]
- Three Packages of 3" x 5" lined index cards
- One Package of 10 markers [Science, Social Studies, PROS]
- Two Packages of 8 plastic dividers
- Two Boxes Kleenex
- One Package of Highlighter markers
- Two Packages black or blue ballpoint pens
- One Package red grading pens
- Three Packages #2 pencils
- One Small personal pencil sharpener
- Two Bottle Elmer's glue [Science, Math]
- One Spiral Notebook (college ruled) for Math Plus
