A NOTE FROM THE PRINCIPAL.....

Come visit with your child's teacher and see how they are doing. Progress reports will be handed out at this time. It will be an early release day for students. The MS will release at 2:30.



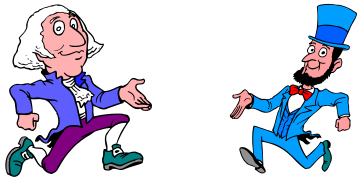
Valentine's Day

Current members will be taking nominations for next year's PTA officers.

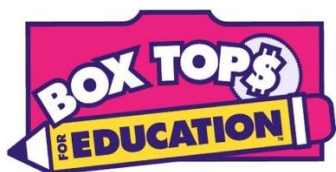

TARDIES—

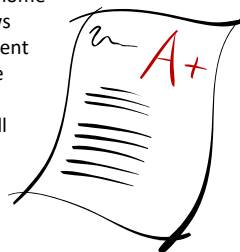
A student is only allowed 4 excused tardies to first period per semester. After the fifth tardy, the student will receive 4 class periods of ISS

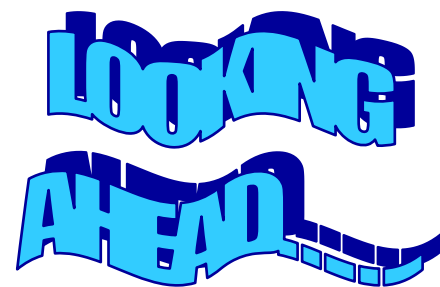


Parents.....When you have a change of address or a new phone number, please let the office know ASAP! If an emergency should happen, we need to be able to reach you with our automated school calling system.
