‘California Drought - a Big Picture Perspective’

Keynote Speaker: Carl Nettleton

Presentation:

While media reports provide snippets of the causes of drought and what it takes to provide reliable sources of water into the future, the real story involves atmospheric rivers, understanding El Niños and La Niñas, and the role of climate change and its impacts. Does it matter if San Diego is in a drought? What is the role of the State Water Project, the Colorado River, and the Rocky Mountains in maintain supplies not only in California but throughout the West. What is the water/energy nexus and why is it important? These and other issues affecting water supply will be discussed.

Keynote Speaker:

Carl Nettleton is an acclaimed writer, speaker, facilitator, and analyst. His stories regularly appear in the Huffington Post, Triple Pundit, and the Independent Voter Network. As a speaker, moderator and facilitator he has appeared in numerous international, national, regional and local forums. He heads Nettleton Strategies, an environmental policy firm specializing in oceans, water, energy, climate, and U.S. Mexico border issues. Carl also founded OpenOceans Global, an NGO linking people to the world's oceans. Carl also serves on the National and California advisory councils for Environmental Entrepreneurs (E2), a national, nonpartisan group of business owners, investors and others who advocate for policies that are good for the economy and good for the environment. He is also active with the San Diego Regional Chamber of Commerce Energy and Water Committee, the international Eye on Earth initiative, and other business and environmental organizations.
