### Bali: Four Seasons Resort Bali at Jimbaran Bay



First made famous by the sport's goofy-foot guru Gerry Lopez in the mid-1970s, Bali has become a bucket-list destination due to the grinding barrels at breaks such as G-Land, Uluwatu, and Nusa Dua. Within a half-hour drive from the latter two, **Jimbaran Bay** is a great base for beginners and home to the Rip Curl and Balangan Wave surf schools. While the big swells surge from April through October, more consistent but smaller surf is supplied from November through March.

When you are all paddled-out for the day, the Four Seasons Resort Bali at Jimbaran Bay offers 156 villas and residences—each with a private pool—for you to glide into. The resort's Learn to Surf package includes accommodation, a 1-hour lesson with a Tropicsurf instructor, and breakfast for two at Taman Wantilan restaurant. The resort's Healing Village Spa—offering eight different forms of massage—will help you maintain balance when not on the board. Room rates start at \$649 per night, based on double occupancy.
