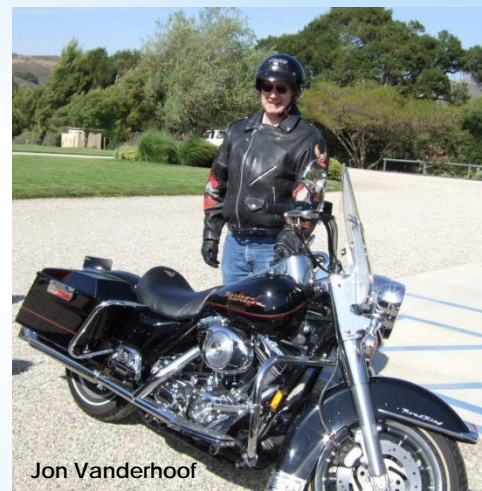

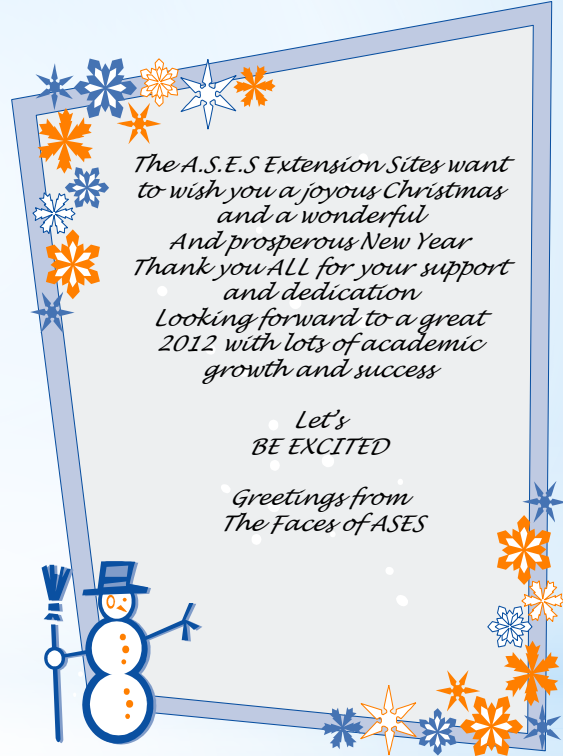


The Angel Tree

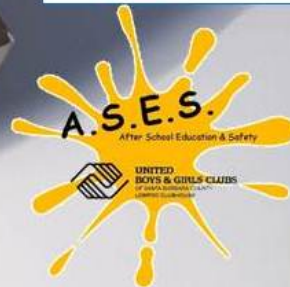
