Thank you to all the students who brought in presents for our Christmas Party Gift Exchange. Each student received a gift, and everyone had lots of fun at the party.

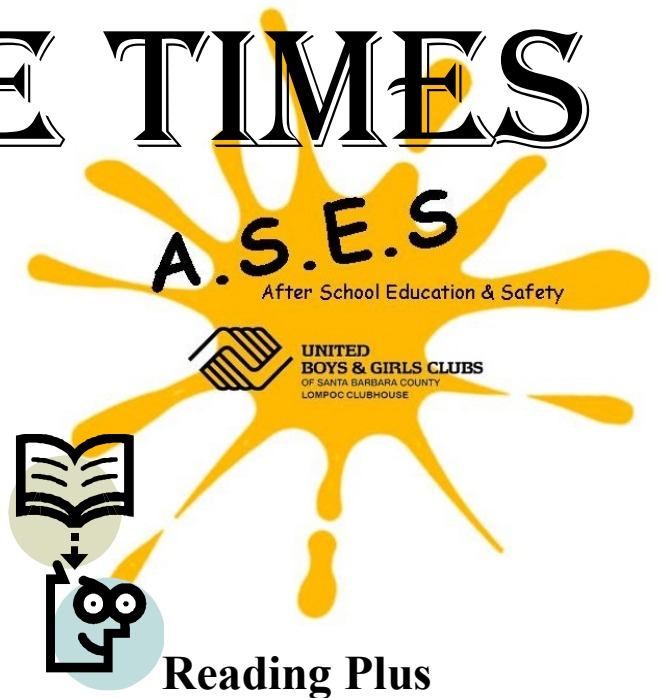
A huge thank you goes out to all the parents who donated money for the pizza and juice.

- Eme: Because I'm nice to kids.

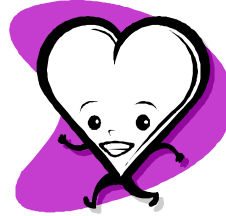
How did it make you feel to be chosen?
