

The Process of Paper Cutting

1. Sketches

Think over a topic for your work and make a sketch.

Think about which parts of your work should be cut out and which of them should be remained as a part of your work. Indicate with x sign those parts

on a sketch, which you are going to cut off. It will help you to be well oriented and not to be confused which parts are meant to be cut off and which ones are meant to be remained in your work.

If your work includes a lot of details, make sure that all of them have a connection with other elements or with the edging of work. It will help the cutting elements of your design not to be fallen out or to be fallen to pieces.

2. Transfer Your Design On A Piece Of Paper

Transfer your design on a prepared piece of paper by any convenient way to you.

You should always pattern on the reverse side of paper in order to save a preciseness of a front page of it.

3. Cut Out the Design

Cut out all the space that is needed to be eliminated from the design step by step.

A sharp blade of a knife is a key to success in a cutting process. Make sure

that the blade of your knife is always sharp enough. In case of necessity, replace the blade of it.

4. Complete Your Design

Stick your work on a piece of paper that will be the background. Mark some

small dots of glue on the back part of your cut drawing and glue it to the background.

And now work is ready!
