**Limit:** One tree per property owner while supplies last. Volunteer planting help available only for residents of Santa Margarita town proper. Residents of surrounding areas, e.g. Garden Farms and Tassajara Canyon, are welcome to reserve/pick up trees as available for their own planting projects.
