ABUSE

Psalm 147:3 He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.

Isaiah 61:3...To give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness...

ADDICTIONS

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Romans 5:20...But where sin abounded, grace abounded much more.

Romans 13:14 Put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts.

ANXIETY

Philippians 4:6,7 Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. 7 And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

BACKSLIDDEN

Jeremiah 3:22...I will heal your backslidings.

DEATH & TRAGEDY (NEED COMFORT)

2 Corinthians 1:3,4 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort those who are in any trouble, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.

DEPRESSION

Isaiah 61:...To give them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness...

FAMILY PROBLEMS

Isaiah 32:17-18...And the effect of righteousness, quietness and assurance forever. My people will dwell in a peaceful habitation, in secure dwellings, and in quiet resting places...

FEAR

2 Timothy 1:7 For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

Hebrews 13:6...The LORD is my helper; I will not fear...

FINANCES/PROVISION

Philippians 4:19 My God shall supply all my needs according to His riches in glory.

GENERATIONAL CURSES

Galatians 3:13 Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree")...

GOD'S DIRECTION

Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

HELP

Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

HEALING

1 Peter 2:24-25 Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.

Psalms 107:20 He sent His word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

INSECURITY/SELF ESTEEM

Psalms 139:14 I will praise you; for I am fearfully *and* wonderfully made: marvelous *are* your works; and *that* my soul knows very well.

JOB PROBLEMS

Psalms 55:22 Cast your burden on the LORD, And He shall sustain you; He shall never permit the righteous to be moved.

LUST

Colossians 3:5 Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry.

MARRIAGE PROBLEMS

Jeremiah 32:27 Behold, I am the LORD, the God of all flesh. Is there anything too hard for Me?

Psalms 127:1 Unless the LORD builds the house, They labor in vain who build it; Unless the LORD guards the city, The watchman stays awake in vain.

RELATIONSHIPS

Ecclesiastes 4:9-10 Two *are* better than one, because they have a good reward for their labor. For if they fall, one will lift up his companion. But woe to him *who is* alone when he falls.

SEEKING EMPLOYMENT

Mark 11:24 Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.

Psalms 5:12 For You, O LORD, will bless the righteous; With favor You will surround him as with a shield.

SALVATION FOR A LOVED ONE

2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

WISDOM AND GUIDANCE

James 1:5-6 If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.
