## CRUCIFY THE FLESH

John Garza

In Galatians 5:24 Paul said, “those who are Christ’s **have crucified** the flesh with its passions and desires.” Crucifixion was so shameful in the ancient world that most would not speak the word. Why then would Paul use such vivid and forceful language to describe the Christian’s obligation?

First, Paul said crucify because we must think about calvary. What was done to Jesus is what must be done to the works of the flesh. When we consider the crucifixion, it was a concentrated effort to embarrass, silence, and discredit Jesus. He was nailed to the cross and left to suffer. He was tortured and murdered, and even so, we must crucify the works of the flesh. We must silence and discredit them.

Second, Paul said crucify because we must get away from the edge of sin. Sadly, many in the Lord’s church are “close enough” Christians. Not really clean of speech, but

“close enough.” Not modest, but “close enough.” Close enough that we do not think that anyone will call us out on it, but Paul said CRUCIFY. Have nothing to do with the works of the flesh.

Finally, Paul said crucify because crucifixion is synonymous with obedience. It is the deepest most profound sense of obedience. As Christians, obedience is taking up the cross (Luke 9:23). Obedience is being crucified with Christ, and Christ living in us (Gal. 2:20). Friends, our Lord Jesus was made perfect by His obedience, and we will be too if we obey Him (Heb. 5:8-9). Therefore, we should understand that crucifying the flesh requires the deepest and most profound sense of obedience.
