Dear Parents/Guardians:

Salutations to All.

From the autumn, along with a few Principal colleagues of mine, I have met with some Faculty and the Administration of St. Francis Prep H.S. We have been working on a plan for an affiliation between our elementary schools and their high school – all to benefit the students. For now, as a first good interaction, here is what has come into being:

- A total of 10 pupils from S.R.B. from Grades 7 & 8, on two consecutive weekends in March, from 9 to Noon at S.F.P., gratis, taught by S.F.P. Teachers, based on a 9th Gr. Curriculum, can attend either one of these two workshops – Dance or Science/Math/English.
Dance Wkshp. - Dance history, modern dance technique, contemporary dance routines, and Broadway show dance routines.
Science, Math, English Wkshp. - Using the high school lab, our students will conduct a given experiment backed by data and observation; topics that incorporate algebra and geometry; and, reading a 9th grade piece to then lead into a writing experience to inspire clarity and confidence in one's own writing.

Our ten students are ready to go, and looking forward to this new experience with the goal of more joint ventures for others.
