REVEREND JOHN J. GRIBBON



Rev. John J. Gribbon was a beloved priest who served the St. Anastasia Parish in Douglasson, NY for 39 years. He was born in Brooklyn, and grew up as an only child in Queens Village. He attended Cathedral College in Brooklyn and the Seminary of the Immaculate Conception in Huntington, NY.

He was ordained at St. James Cathedral in Brooklyn on June 3, 1950. Friends, co-workers, and parishioners remember Fr. Gribbon as a gentle man who was particularly well-loved by children and single-minded in his devotion to the priesthood. He dedicated his life to service and would donate his salary to the parish, refusing to even go on vacation other than to take his mother away once a year. In November 2008, 245th Street was renamed Fr. John J. Gribbon Way in honor of his many years of service to the community.

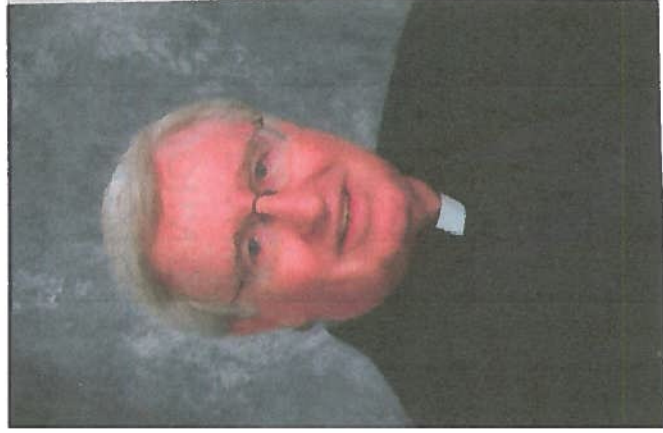

MSGR. MARTIN T. GERAGHTY



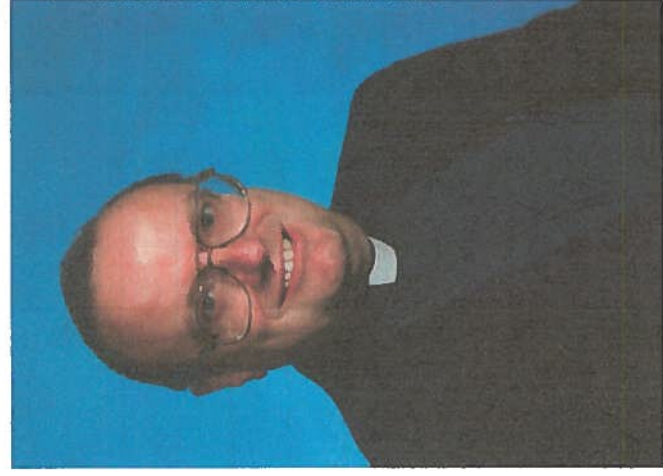
Msgr. Geraghty is grateful for the privilege of serving as Pastor of St. Robert's Parish since the Spring of 2006. He has been inspired by the love and vibrancy of the community of faith that is our parish. From 1988 to 2006, he was pastor of St. Francis de Sales Parish in Belle Harbor, NY. From 1970 to 1988, he taught Theology and served as Academic Dean at Cathedral College in Douglaston. He also served as a parish priest in St. Joan of Arc Parish in Jackson Heights. He was ordained a priest in St. Peter's Basilica in Rome on December 16, 1964.

Msgr has a deep interest in Jewish Christian Relations and has been active in the interfaith endeavors since 1965. At present he is a member of the Northeast Queens Catholic Jewish Relations Council.

In 1973, he was Co-Founder and first Director of The Brooklyn Diocesan School of Languages. He claims that his experience with the Language Institute helped his golf. He can say, "Can I have a mulligan for that drive?" in seven languages. Msgr. Geraghty was born in Brooklyn and can still speak his local dialect.

Msgr. Anthony F. Sherman, STD, currently serves as Pastor of St. Anastasia Parish in Douglaston, NY and has also served as Associate Pastor and Pastor of St. Matthias Parish in Ridgewood. As part of his pastoral duties he deals with both the academic and pastoral aspect of liturgy.

Prior to joining St. Anastasia Parish, Msgr. Sherman served as the Executive Director of the USCCB Secretariat of Divine Worship. Msgr. Sherman holds a Master's in Theology and a Doctorate in Sacred Theology, with a major in liturgy from the University of Innsbruck, Austria. He was also an Adjunct Professor of Liturgy at Immaculate Conception Seminary, Huntington NY for more than twenty years.

Msgr. Sherman is a member of the North American Academy of Liturgy and the Catholic Academy of Liturgy. He has published on the subjects of death and dying, Baptismal preparation and the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults.

David Risueño was born in Brooklyn, NY. He is the oldest of seven children. His family was a "Brooklyn Family". David attended the Public School System and graduated from Brooklyn Technical High School. While attending Brooklyn College, a classmate invited him to his cousin Milagros (aka Millie) sweet sixteen birthday party. After serving two years in the Army during the Vietnam War, David came home to marry his childhood sweetheart Millie in 1967 - and left Brooklyn for Bayside. David enrolled in City College and completed his degree in Civil Engineering. On Christmas morning 1976, tragedy struck the Risueño Family when a hit and run accident left David an amputee. Unable to teach his son Keith to ride a bicycle, he and Millie joined the Cub Scout Program sponsored by St. Robert Bellarmine and became parishioners. In 1977 David became the registered leader of Cub Scout Pack 142 and today he is the Committee Chairman of both Cub Scout Pack 142 and Boy Scout Troop 142. During his tenure, David and the scout families have participated in many of the St. Robert Bellarmine events including the St. Robert Ministry Fair, the St. Robert Feast Day Celebration, and the St. Robert Bazaars, just to name a few. David and Millie have raised two sons - Keith and Travis - both of whom attended St. Robert Bellarmine School prior to graduating from Cardozo High School. As scouts, Keith earned his Eagle Scout Badge and Travis his Star Scout Badge. In addition to Scouting, David is a member of the City College Alumni Association, the American Society of Civil Engineers and is a member of the 911 Museum.
