## Energy Efficiency Upgrades

Holroyd City Council was successful in receiving funding from the Australian Government to implement Council's Energy Smart Cities and Homes Project. Funding assisted in energy efficiency upgrades in council owned facilities and community buildings. The program aims to improve energy management practices, infrastructure and annual cost savings.

The energy efficiency works were implemented at Guildford West Children's Centre and included installation of energy efficient air conditioning. **Energy efficiency after installation improved by 3167.2 kWh with estimated cost savings of \$4,639 per annum and the equivalent in emissions savings to 1.5 return Sydney to Melbourne road trips per year.**
