Energy Efficiency Upgrades

Holroyd City Council was successful in receiving funding from the Australian Government to implement Council's Energy Smart Cities and Homes Project. Funding assisted in energy efficiency upgrades in council owned facilities and community buildings. The program aims to improve energy management practices, infrastructure and annual cost savings

The energy efficiency works implemented at Gumnut Grove Children's Centre include an energy efficient lighting retrofit. **Energy efficiency after installation improved by 3785.3 kWh with estimated cost savings of \$800 per annum and the equivalent in emissions savings to 2 return Sydney to Melbourne road trips per year.**
