PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The current SCC Transit Center accommodates an estimated 9000 passenger boardings and alightings a week and is expected to grow as new connections are added. Elements of the project include:

- Additional passenger loading zones
- Improved pedestrian connections
- Enhanced passenger amenities
- Real Time signage
- Traffic signal upgrades to facilitate bus access

BUDGET & TIMELINE

- Estimated project cost \$5M
- Construction targeted for 2019

BENEFITS

The Upriver Transit Center is a new transit center that will:

- Provide regional transit hub connecting the Cities of Spokane, Spokane Valley and Millwood as well as unincorporated Spokane County
- Address overcrowding at the current facility
- Improve access to higher education
- Build on the success of the student Universal Transit Access Pass (UTAP) program
- Complement north Spokane Corridor project's multimodal goals
- Make important transit connections to the region via the Central City Line and other routes
