

PHOTOGRAPHY TIPS FOR CHILDREN

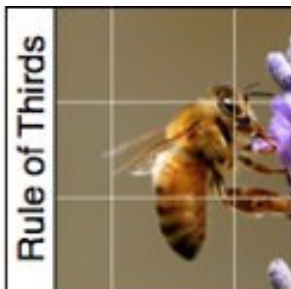
- **EXPERIMENT:** shoot from different sides (Up, Down, Close and Far, from the Side)
- **CHECK THE BACKGROUND:** Avoid clutter or distraction
- **HOLD THE CAMERA STRAIGHT:** unless you want a specific effect
- **HOW TO HOLD THE CAMERA:**



- **GETTING CLOSE:** Use the zoom in the camera or use YOUR LEGS!!! Sometimes you want the subject to filled the entire FRAME. (What is a frame?)
- **TAKE LOTS OF PHOTOS OF THE SUBJECT:** Today ...we won't do that though because we are sharing the camera with other students.
- **MAKE SURE YOU BALANCE THE AMOUNT OF "PEOPLE" photos with the AMOUNT OF "places or things" photos.**
- **FIND A POINT OF INTEREST**



- **RULE OF THIRD:** Divide the frame into three equal parts, and try to have your main subject occupy 1/3 of those parts.



- **FOCAL MODES:** Use it for different situations. **MACRO** for Close Ups, **FLASH** for night, **SCENES** or **PEOPLE** sometimes.
