## **STABLING**

### **STABLE MONITOR**

Selina will be onsite from **Monday 5<sup>th</sup> March** until **Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> March**

Stable access is available beginning **Tuesday 06 March from 10 AM.**

**Stable Monitor Hours (Tues-Sat) 6 AM – 9:30 PM**

There is strictly **NO** access out of these times.

Please **DO NOT** ring and ask to have your stables unlocked unless you or a representative (who will be responsible and sign on your behalf, knows the stable numbers and if required the amount of shavings ordered, etc) **are on the grounds.**

The correct horses need to go in the stable allocated. There is to be **NO MOVING** them around without explicit permission from the Stable Monitor.

Extra shavings are available through Selina and must be paid for at the time of ordering: **CASH ONLY.**

Tools for cleaning stables – forks, shovels, rakes, wheelbarrows - will **NOT** be provided by SIEC. Exhibitors are required to bring their own tools for cleaning stables.

Wheeled upright refuse containers – aka ‘wheelie bins’ – are **NOT** to be used to empty shavings/manure from stables under ANY circumstances. Exhibitors found using these refuse containers for stable cleaning will be charged to replace the container at cost.

Aisles, as well as access to all stable blocks, **MUST NOT** be blocked with curtains or any impediment. Should SIEC deem your decorations/set-up to be in violation of the fire code, you will be asked to remove such items to enforce regulatory compliance and safety.

Refuse is to be placed in the available upright bins in the stabling area. Please do not place your refuse near the bin, next to the bin, or on top of the bin. Open the lid, and put your rubbish inside. SIEC charges extra to clean improperly discarded rubbish. These charges will be passed on to exhibitors with increased entry fees. Please help us make the show affordable and enjoyable for all.

Stables will be monitored 24 hours by SIEC security. Please remember that all activity is recorded on security cameras. Any misconduct towards exhibitors and/or horses will **NOT** be tolerated.

### **PLEASE NOTE**

**NO THONGS are to be worn in the stabling area.**

Toes are liable to be chopped off if exposed.

**Absolutely NO SMOKING in the stable areas – NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Should you be caught smoking, you will be assumed to be on fire, and appropriate actions will be taken to ‘put you out’, not excluding hosing down, dousing with buckets or calling the fire brigade. All costs incurred to exterminate the fire will be borne by the inflamed.

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## **CABINS**

**KEYS** can be collected from Selina, the Stable Monitor (details above), who is based in the stable area.

Cabin key pick-up & return is available **ONLY** during allotted hours (refer to Stable Monitor).

Cabin Key returns are to Selina **ONLY** to ensure you are marked off accordingly. Should your key not be returned to the Stable Monitor prior to departure, you will be charged a \$100 replacement fee.

Please be mindful of other cabin occupants in your vicinity. Noise should be kept to a minimum between the hours of 11 PM & 5 AM. Should you wish to enjoy music and conversation, the Riders Retreat is available for socialising for all exhibitors.

**Absolutely NO extension cords are to be used from ANY cabin into the Camping area, or into any vehicle, appliance, etc. outside of the cabin. All infractions will incur a \$500 fine and may result in expulsion from the cabin.**

## **CAMPING**

The Camping Monitor is **Bob Krog**. Bob has final authority on ALL camping matters.

Bob will be monitoring all campsites. Please check in with Bob before placing your caravan, truck and/or float into your designated campsite. It is essential that your vehicle be situated within the confines of your designated campsite. Any overlap between sites will not be tolerated. You will be asked to move your vehicle if not parked/positioned properly.

SIEC has issued an official statement regarding campsites – how they are determined and how charges are applied. Please refer to this document for all questions pertaining to the definition of a campsite and associated charges.

SIEC will be counting campsites each day with Bob. All additional charges **MUST** be settled in the show office prior to the start of each show day or exhibits may be prevented from entering the ring.

Please be mindful of other campers in your vicinity. Noise should be kept to a minimum between the hours of 11 PM & 5 AM. Should you wish to enjoy music and conversation, the Riders Retreat is available for socialising for all exhibitors.

## **DAY PARKING**

Exhibitors utilising Day Parking will be asked to utilise **Parking Area P7** near Arena 11, **Parking Area P9** near the Hacking Arena and the **North Truck Park**. There is another event utilising the Main Arena closest to the SIEC entrance that will be occupying the larger Day Parking areas in P1 & P2.

### **Re. Accommodation at SIEC – Camp Sites**

Visitors are considered to occupy a camp site if they are utilising a power outlet or sleeping on site (e.g. in sleeping accommodation such as a float, trailer, tent, marquee, vehicle, etc).

If additional power outlets are used, charges will apply accordingly for additional camp sites. For example, if two power outlets are being used, charges will apply for two camp sites.

A maximum of two forms of sleeping accommodation (e.g. a tent and a float) may occupy a single camp site. Providing they are only using one power outlet between them, charges will only apply for one camp site.

The number of camp sites utilised is calculated and recorded each day by a member of the Organising Committee and a Security Officer.

Note:

- Trade stand operators who sleep in their vehicles will be charged for a camp site
- Marquees and cars will not be charged unless there are people sleeping in them.
