What is the coming of the Son of Man that Jesus speaks of? (vv. 22–37)

Wednesday – Luke 18

What is the key difference between the pharisee and the tax collector? (vv. 9–14)

Why do riches make it hard for a person to enter the kingdom of heaven? (vv. 24–25)

Why do the disciples not understand Jesus in verse 34?

Thursday – Luke 19

Why is Zacchaeus honored by Jesus? (vv. 1–10)

What should we be doing while we are waiting for the Kingdom? (vv. 11–27)

Why does Jesus weep over Jerusalem? (vv. 41–44)

Friday – Luke 20

What is the significance of the word “likeness” in Jesus’s reply? (v. 24)

What is Jesus’s argument in verse 37?

What is the answer to Jesus’ question in verse 44?
