Who are truly the "blind" people in this story? (vv. 24-41)

Why was it so terrible to be cast out of the synagogue? (vv. 22, 34)

Is this story a metaphor about people becoming Christians? (v. 39)

## Thursday - John 10

What is the connection between the thieves and wolves of John 10 and the Pharisees in John 9? (vv. 7-13)

How do believers know we can trust Jesus? (vv. 3-5; 25-27)

Did Jesus claim to be God? (vv. 30-38)

# Friday - John 11

Why did Lazarus die? (vv. 1-16)

Should a Christian fear death? (vv. 25-26)

How did Caiaphas prophesy? (vv. 49-53)
