(vv. 11-14) Thursday - John 15 What is the criterion for having effective prayers? (v. 7) What kind of joy does a believer receive from Jesus? (v. 11) Who testifies to Jesus' ministry? (v. 26-27) Friday - John 16 Why is it advantageous that Jesus ascended to heaven? (vv. 7-11) What is the ministry of the Holy Spirit? (vv. 7-11)
