(vv. 10-20) Thursday - Revelation 2 What was the sin of the church of Ephesus and what is the solution that Jesus provides? (vv. 1-7) How was Satan's throne in Pergamum? (v. 13)

What is the reward of those who are faithful? (vv. 25-29)

Friday - Revelation 3

Why was Sardis "dead"? (vv. 1-6)

What is demonstrated by the Christian's triumph? (v. 9)

Does verse 20 teach that we should ask Jesus into our hearts?
